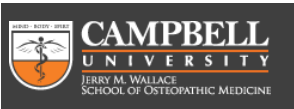
Over the last few days, God has created several significant partnerships between us and other ministries who are working to equip and launch healthcare students and professionals into the world for Kingdom work. You will now have a part in so much more. Thank you for making this happen!

Here’s a brief summary:

**SIM** Andrea Wilson was interviewing Heather Buck, RN for a medical missionary position with SIM, a large missionary sending agency. Ten years ago Heather attended the Preceptorship and repeatedly told Andrea about the positive impact it had on her. Andrea contacted us, spent a week with us at the 2015 Preceptorship, and became convinced that she wanted to see some SIM people become equipped just like Heather. Hence, we’ll partner with SIM to provide a dual US/international experience where SIM students will attend the 2016 Preceptorship and then leave to serve in medical mission hospitals in Nigeria.



MedSend enables highly qualified and dedicated healthcare professionals to serve spiritually and physically needy people around the world in the name of Christ. MedSend does this by making their monthly educational loan payments while they serve. Without MedSend, these healthcare professionals would need to spend years working in the U.S. to pay off their educational debt before going and being able to answer God’s call to serve – and many would never make it to the mission field at all.
