During a Preceptorship beach outing, Kyle heard two men on a harbor rock frantically yelling for medical help. As 911 was called, he swam out to find an unconscious third man. He conducted a quick assessment, briefly revived this highly inebriated person, and awaited further help. Within minutes, lifeguards, 3 fire trucks, an ambulance, multiple police, two Orange County sheriff's boats, and a sheriff's helicopter all responded. Thirty minutes later, rescuers were able to move the man to a boat and transport him to awaiting medical personnel. Kyle suspected he would be OK.
