The next morning, Bob received this text from a ministry leader:

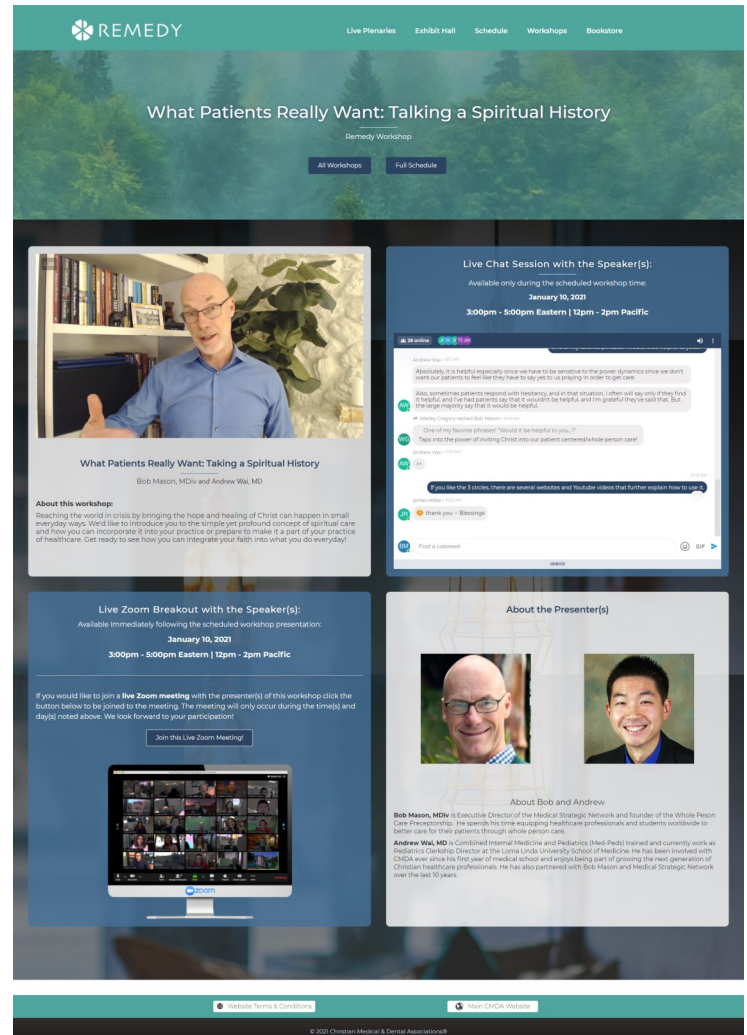
“Morning, Bob, excellent job with the spiritual history breakout at Remedy. It was the best breakout I watched.”
