

Fridays at the Med Center



It happens most Fridays during the academic year. Medical students gather as Christ followers at the Medical Center to develop their professional skills to care for the spiritual needs of their patients.

Over the year, they'll explore the ethical basis for assessing and addressing patients' spiritual needs. They become competent in taking a Spiritual History. They'll develop skills in common spiritual interventions such as prayer and sharing the gospel. They'll discover vital resources they can share with patients.

More, they'll get experience doing this with real patients who are facing real healthcare issues in the hospital. And after full participation over the year, they get a certificate that can be beneficial in their residency applications.

Last Friday, one student shared:

"Before attending this session, I was very curious to hear what questions were on the spiritual history and how effective they might be. To my delight, I found that the questions on the history were well designed to dig to the root spiritual and emotional issues of the patients that we spoke to, and that they clearly helped us to understand where they stood spiritually. In similar 'spiritual history' opportunities in the past, I haven't always been able to know where individuals stand in their walk (or non-walk) with God. I believe due to the deep and open-ended nature of these questions, this style of spiritual history taking can strongly assist clinicians in knowing where to begin to addressing spiritual and emotional needs of their patients."

Fridays help develop leaders. Experienced students help serve as coaches during patient visits. Often students lead the training times. Our hope is that these leaders will multiply this to others during their residencies, fellowships and long into their practices.

God is using your gifts to bring hope to patients in need. He's also equipping gifted Christian students to live on mission wherever they go.
